Respectful Relationships

On Thursday we had visitors from North-West Victoria Region to our implementation team meeting for our Respectful Relationships program. Together we completed an audit of our current position on Respectful Relationships and we can now move forward with planning how it will be implemented school wide. Whilst the grade 5/6 team have begun lessons, the rest of the school will begin incorporating the course from second semester this year. Staff will participate in professional learning in early Term 3 and ongoing. The Respectful Relationships curriculum is delivered under eight topic headings:

- Emotional Literacy
- Personal Strengths
- Positive Coping
- Problem Solving
- Stress Management
- Help-Seeking
- Gender and Identity and
- Positive Gender Relations

By incorporating a whole-school approach to this program we will review our existing procedures and culture to ensure that they model respectful relationships and gender equality practices across the entire school community.
