Congratulations to the MPS soccer team! This week they competed in the regional finals where they came runners up. Champion effort to all involved and a big thanks to their coach Simon.

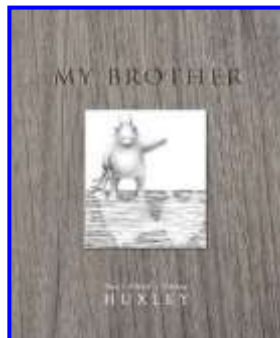


FAMILY COOKING
