The DET has advised all Victorian schools that we should only charge fees for items that will be used by students that can be taken home by them at some stage of the year. **This means that we need to rely heavily on voluntary contributions to help fund many other programs and teacher resources.**

Please find the fee schedule for Grade Prep attached. **Payment of \$75 for the stationery pack must be prepaid by 27th November 2020, it will be ready for collection on 27th January 2021. Our preferred payment method is via Compass. (If payment hasn't been received by the due date we will assume you are purchasing your own).**

Moreland Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

SECTION A: Essential Student Learning Items

SECTION C: Voluntary Contributions

General Contribution

Moreland Primary School continues to welcome your voluntary contributions to support our school. You can make a general voluntary contribution that goes towards all of our school's important priorities for 2021 as well as providing additional activities and services for all students. Due to the new DET requirements to itemise parent contributions the school must now rely heavily on general voluntary contributions for teacher resources and extra student programs.

Building Fund

The school also has a building fund which is used ONLY for building maintenance and repairs and is also voluntary. The building fund is tax deductible and in the past has been able to partially fund the new courtyard playground which was completed at the end of 2019 and also the external painting of the building which was completed in October this year. Priorities for the future will include replacement of carpets, bike shed upgrade, playground works and upstairs courtyard.
