RECIPE:

3 cups self-sing flour (extra flour for kneading)

1 cup cream

1 cup lemonade and pinch of salt

Each batch makes about 15 scones

Bake for 15 minutes in a pre-heated oven at 220 degrees Celsius














Maths News from Grade 1/2 Prue's Group

Real-life Problems! A great way for students to use their mathematical skills in a meaningful way.

Look at what 1/2 Prue's Maths Group solved.

On Tuesday, 3rd May and Friday, 6th May we will be going on an excursion to Merri Creek. We need to go in 2 groups because there are too many students to go on one day. How many children altogether?

Numbers you need to know:-

1/2 A 23 students 1/2 C 24 students 1/2 B 25 students 1/2 E 22 students

1/2 D 24 students Bus carries 57 passengers


We have decided on Tuesday 1/2C and 1/2E with 5 adults will go.

How many people altogether?

How many buses will we need?

On Friday 1/2A, 1/2B and 1/2D will go with 10 adults. How many people will go on Friday? How many buses will we need?

It was interesting to see so many of the students making mental computations to work out how many students were in the Grade 1/2 area. We talked about the different strategies people used. MAB, which is used a lot in the school was available or we drew the numbers as shown. This visual representation using MAB made this a problem all students could solve. Below is 1/2C, 1/2E and the 5 adults



Here are some pictures of the students using number facts to 10 and 20 to help build automatic response and exploring dominoes. Using dominoes helped student to look at the way different numbers can join together to make the same number i.e. (8,4) (6,6), (9,3) all equal 12.
